B&W Pantex

Babcock & Wilcox Technical Services Pantex, LLC, (B&W Pantex) is the management and operating contractor at the U.S. Department of Energy / National Nuclear Security Administration's Pantex Plant.

The Pantex Plant is a government-owned, contractor-operated facility. B&W Pantex is responsible for the Plant's operations involving nuclear weapons, plutonium pit storage, high explosives, engineering, safety, security, facilities management, quality, environmental protection and general administration.

Approximately 3,300 employees work for B&W Pantex at the site, located northeast of Amarillo, Texas, in Carson County.

The Plant's annual Fiscal-Year funding is approximately \$517 million.

After being awarded a five-year Cost Plus Award Fee contract, B&W Pantex assumed operations at the Plant on February 1, 2001. The DOE/NNSA extended the contract to September 30, 2010, and recently DOE/NNSA announced its intention to award a contract extension for a one-year base period to September 30, 2011, plus two three-month options which may be exercised if needed.

B&W Pantex is a Limited Liability Company (LLC) formed specifically to operate the Pantex Plant. Its Members are BWX Technologies, Inc., Honeywell International, Inc. and Bechtel National, Inc.

The President and General Manager of B&W Pantex is John Woolery. Scott Kennedy is the Deputy General Manager of B&W Pantex.
