### **John Woolery, President & General Manager, B&W Pantex**

**J**ohn Woolery was named President & General Manager of B&W Pantex in 2010. He served as B&W Pantex Vice President & Deputy General Manager, Operations, from April 2008 to February 2010. Prior to becoming deputy, Mr. Woolery spent almost three years as the Director of Program Management for Directed Stockpile Weapons Work and Engineering & Science Campaigns. Mr. Woolery also served as the acting Division Manager for Safeguards & Security as well as the Division Manager for the Quality & Performance Assurance organization at Pantex.

Prior to coming to Pantex in 2003, Mr. Woolery gained more than 14 years of experience in DOE/NNSA with Honeywell Federal Manufacturing & Technologies at the Kansas City Plant, which manufactures electrical and mechanical Major Components and subassemblies for nuclear weapons programs. In previous positions, Mr. Woolery was the Program Manager with responsibility for all of the production programs at the KCP for a period of over four years during which time, the plant achieved several programmatic First Production Units for Major Components and consistently delivered over 100,000 items on an annual basis with an on-time delivery performance of 99.997%. Prior to moving to Program Management, he had been the manager of Firing Systems engineering and manager of Manufacturing Group X support.

Mr. Woolery has developed an extensive knowledge of virtually every functional aspect of the Nuclear Security Enterprise as a result of the variety of management roles and responsibilities he has had throughout his career. The breadth and depth of the rotational assignments has provided a diverse background of engineering, manufacturing operations, program management, safety, security, and quality management experience.
